

You are no doubt aware that the Plough and Fleece pub has been closed for some time and the landlord applied to Babergh Council for a change of use to a private dwelling. This application (and its appeal) was met with a strong community response, which was considered in the Council's rejection decision(s).

The pub is now officially recognised as an Asset of Community Value (ACV), which means that as it has come up for sale, the community will be making bid for the pub.

OUR VISION
